PRODUCT DATA SHEET – HEXDALLE® XE AMY AND AMY EXTENSION TILES

I. CHARACTERISTICS

The tile is made of recycled black rubber aggregate which has been sorted and graded, bound by volume-dyed polyurethane elastomer resin. As a result of the composition, expansion in heat and shrinking in the cold are normal. Other processed chemical elements are used in the composition of our tiles to give them their solidity and elasticity.



II. COLOURS

Brick red – Green – Black – Grey – Chocolate - Flecked with beige EPDM aggregate During storage, make sure the elements are not partially exposed to UV rays as this will affect the colour. If the colour of the tiles is not exactly uniform, simply wait a few weeks for the colour to even out. A colour loss can occur without altering the characteristics of the tile. Green is more sensitive to UV rays than red. A special PU 63 non-slip paint can be applied by airless spraying by a specialist to renovate the appearance of the HEXDALLE[®] XE AMY tile that has faded with time.

III. USE

The Hexdalle[®] XE AMY tile is a comfort floor especially designed for spring games. It can also be used as a regular comfort floor for children that may be enlarged thanks to the "AMY extension tile" option.

IV. DIMENSIONS

7.45 sqm tile made of 4 elements of approximately 1.50 m x 1.50 m each.
0.50 m x 1.50 m for the AMY extension tile.
Thickness: 40mm.
Critical Fall Height: 1.00 m
Bevelled edges integrated to the surface
Microporous tile with water drainage system integrated underneath.
Self-stable thanks to its "puzzle" fixing system (no glue needed).



WARNING: IF YOU USE AMY EXTENSIONS BOTH IN LENGTH AND WIDTH, PLAN TO USE 500 X 500 MM 40 MM THICK HEXDALLE® XE TILES THAT YOU WILL GLUE WITH OUR PU59 (ON THE EDGE).

V. LAYING INSTRUCTIONS

2 people are necessary to lay the structure.

- 1. Assemble 2 pieces together
- 2. Assemble the 3rd piece with the others
- 3. Assemble the 4^{th} one with the first 3.
- 4. We highly recommended to fix the AMY tiles on the edges thanks to our PU59 liquid glue. This will help prevent from robbery or vandalism.

Laying cost is reduced thanks to the gain of time made with the "puzzle" fixing system.



No need to pour a concrete slab underneath the tile. Nevertheless, the ground needs to be stable and plane (compacted construction aggregate, etc.).



WARNING: DO NOT MOVE THE RUBBER TILES USING THE "T" ELEMENTS

VI. MAINTENANCE

In accordance with the *Journal Officiel de la République Francaise* of 26.12.1996, operators or managers must draw up a maintenance plan to check the state of the tiles. This inspection can be done annually or more frequently depending on how intensively the play area is used and the climatic conditions – Cleaning, check of the H.I.C and the state of the shock-absorbing covering. Tiles should be replaced if necessary.

The HEXDALLE[®] XE AMY tile is designed to keep maintenance costs low. It can be simply washed (maximum 3 Bars) or swept with a soft brush. You can also use our CLEANDALLE FC bactericide fungicide cleaning product. Never use a solvent to clean the tiles.

HEXDALLE® XE AMY is flexible, sound-proof, non-slip, rot-proof and hygienic. It is also pleasant in shape and colour.

VIII. STORAGE

Storage temperature between 15 and 25°C.

Avoid the tiles being partially exposed to UV rays.

Prior to laying, unpack the tiles onto a flat surface so that they recover their characteristics.
